

## **KARABS HIGH POINT RULES - 2017**

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Horses must be registered with either the Arabian Horse Registry, International Arabian Horse Association, or the Anglo-Arabian Registry

The owner and rider must be a member in good standing of the KARABS. Leased horses for the purpose of showing in High Point will be honored under the following requirements:

- (1) Written verification of Lease to accompany nomination.
- (2) The Lessee must be a member in good standing of the KARABS.

### **NOMINATION:**

- (1) A nomination fee of \$30.00 per horse for the must be paid for the Open and Adult Amateur divisions. The fee for the Youth division is \$15. A fee must be paid for each horse and rider combination. Upon receipt of this fee by KARABS, the horse will be eligible to compete in the High Point Program.
- (2) The horse must be entered into the High Point Program and the nomination fee paid prior to earning points towards the program. The nomination form may be submitted along with the point form from the horse's first show of the season. However points earned at shows prior to the horse's nomination will not count.
- (3) A photocopy of the horse's registration papers must accompany the fee. Fees and papers must be received before points will be counted.

### **POINT REQUIREMENTS:**

- (1) Points may be earned at all shows, both AHA sanctioned shows and Open/All Breed. Points earned at the club's show, The Medallion, will count double.
- (2) High Point Program entry period will close November 30th of the program year.
- (3) Points must be submitted on forms supplied by KARABS, and accompanied by a Prize List of the show, unless the Prize List is available on-line, to the High Point Secretary by the closing date of the Program for that year.
- (4) There will be no minimum number of entries required in a class. Double points will be given in any class of 18 or more entries. (Does not apply to regional and national classes).
- (5) The judge may not judge any horse that has been owned, trained, or boarded by them or their immediate family or their employees or their immediate family within 30 days of the show date. This also applies to anyone instructing riding.
- (6) If a horse is sold during an Award year, and the new owner is a member in good standing of KARABS, the points will follow the horse. Otherwise, points will stop at the date of sale.

**AWARD DIVISIONS and CATEGORIES: Top 5 Awards will be given for each category within a division: Champion; Reserve Champion; 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place.**

- (1) Open: This Division is for horses owned or leased by KARABS members that are shown by professionals.  
Two Categories: Purebred Arabian and Half-Arabian
- (2) Adult Amateur: This Division is for horses owned or leased AND shown by adult amateurs.  
Two Categories: Purebred Arabians and Half Arabians
- (3) Youth: This Division is open to KARABS youth members and horses that are owned or leased by them or any member of their immediate family. Purebred and Half Arabians will be combined in each category  
Four Categories: Lead-line 2-6 yrs; Walk-Trot 10yrs & under; Youth 13 yrs & under; Youth 14-18 yrs

### **EXCEPTIONS:**

- (1) The USEF requirements will be KARABS requirements. However, the show need not be USEF Approved.
- (2) Adult Amateurs may cross enter into the Open Division will all points earned by the adult amateur rider counting towards the Open awards. A separate fee must be paid for each division.
- (3) Points earned by the professional rider may not be combined with amateur or youth earned points.
- (4) A horse may be entered in the Open, Adult Amateur and Youth Divisions. However, only point earned by the horse when shown by the adult amateur or youth will count towards the adult amateur and youth divisions, respectively.
- (5) A separate entry fee will be paid for each horse/rider combination.

### **RATING OF SHOWS:**

Points earned at all shows will counts towards the awards. There will be no distinction between points earned at AHA sanctioned shows and open/all breed shows (e.g. county fairs; 4-H shows; other non-AHA shows). However, placings at shows designated as "Schooling shows" will not count towards the awards.

### **SPECIAL NOTES ON POINTS RECEIVED:**

When a show other than a Regional or National Championship awards placings other than the traditional 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, & 5<sup>th</sup>, such as "TOP \*\*", *it is the responsibility of the exhibitor* to find out the horse's actual numeric placing from the show officials before submitting the points to the high point secretary. OTHERWISE, THE POINTS WILL NOT BE COUNTED!!!

### **TO ALL EXHIPITDRS ENTERED IN HIGH POINT:**

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT IN ORDER TO BE FAIR AND IMPARTIAL, ALL POINTS WILL BE CHECKED WITH THE AHA SHOW RECORDS (for AHA SANCTIONED SHOWS). FOR NON-AHA SHOWS WHERE POINTS CANNOT BE VERIFIED, THE HONOR SYSTEM SHALL BE IN PLACE.

SINCE HIGH POINT RUNS UNTIL NOVEMBER 30th OF EACH YEAR, ALL POINTS WON IN OCTOBER MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 30th IN ORDER TO BE COUNTED FOR THE YEAR-END AWARDS.

### **YOUTH DIVISION:**

Any youth who is a member in good standing of KARABS, either by family or individual associated membership, who has not reached his/her 19<sup>th</sup> birthday by December 1<sup>st</sup> of the preceding year is eligible to compete. The youth may compete on either a registered Arabian or Half-Arabian.

A nomination fee of \$15 is required for the each classification in the Youth division. **A nomination form must be filled out and a fee paid for each horse and rider combination.** Once entered as a youth, all points will be counted as youth points. This includes equitation as well as other points.

Youth may enter more than one horse, but each horse must be entered separately and a fee paid for each horse. Points will be accumulated for each horse separately.

Upon submission of a nomination form, each Youth/Horse combination will be entered in the appropriate age grouping.

There will be no Cross-Entering of Youth Riders in the Open Division.

Youth Division points count will be the same as the Open and Adult Amateur divisions. Points must be submitted on a **YOUTH** Point Form to avoid confusion
